# Difference Between 'Ought to' and 'Must'.

### 'Ought to'

1. 'Ought to' is used to express moral obligation, desirability or duty.

**Example:** We **ought to** love our country.

You ought to get better marks.

2. 'Ought to' is used to express strong probability.

Example: He ought to win the race.

She ought to pass in the first division.

3. 'Ought to + have + M.V3' is used to express past obligation.

**Example:** He **ought to** have worked hard.

I **ought to** have visited my brother yesterday.

4. 'Ought to' is used to express advice.

Example: You ought to read the Gita.

Students ought to get up early in the morning.

### 'Must'

1. 'Must' is used to express compulsion or strong moral obligation.

**Example:** Candidates **must** answer at least five out of the ten questions.

One must keep one's promises.

2. 'Must' is used to express fixed determination.

Example: I must have my money back.

We must firmly deal with the antisocial elements.

3. 'Must' is used to express the sense of Inevitable (unavoidable).

Example: We must all die.

If we want to keep ourselves fit, we **must** get up early.

4. 'Must' is used to express duty.

**Example:** A soldier **must** fight for his country.

Everyone must do his duty.
