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
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

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RULES FOR ACTIVE VOICE AND PASSIVE VOICE

1. Passive voice in Simple Present Tense

Active Voice : Formula: Subject + infinitive + object

Passive Voice : Formula: S + to be + past participle + by object

Example : Active: Simson cares the lion.

Passive: The lion is cared by Simson.

2. Passive voice in Present Continuous Tense

Active Voice : Formula : Subject + to be (is, am, are) + present participle + object

Passive Voice : Formula : S + to be (is, am, are) + being + past participle + by object

Example : Active : Bobby is drawing a nice scenery

Passive : A nice scenery is being drawn by Bobby

3. Passive voice in Simple Past Tense

Active Voice : Formula : Subject + past participle + object

Passive Voice : Formula : S + was/were + past participle + by object

Example : Active : The teacher called the students.

Passive : The students were called by the teacher.

4. Passive voice in Past Continuous Tense

Active Voice : Formula : S + was/were + being + past participle + by object

Passive Voice : Formula : S + was/were + being + past participle + by object

Example : Active : I was waiting for Dina.

Passive : Dina was being waited by me.

5. Passive voice in Past Perfect Tense

Active Voice : Formula : Subject + had + past participle + object

Passive Voice : Formula : S + had been + past participle + by object

Example: Active: He had left that place.

Passive: That place had been left by him.

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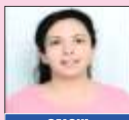
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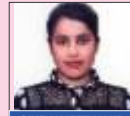
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
